Prizes: \$ 1,000 total value. Prime sprints every 10 laps of Senior race.

Course: Flat, 1 kilometer oval located just South of the White House. Registration Desk, start and finish lines at center of South side, just off Constitution Avenue.

Entries: ABL of A rules to govern. NUMBER OF ENTRANTS IN SENIOR RACE WILL BE LIMITED TO 125 RIDERS FOR REASONS OF SAFETY AND SIZE OF THE COURSE. Entries must be postmarked by June 20 or be subject to post entry fee. Parent or legal guardian of minors must sign entry blank.

Registration: 10:00 A.M. for post entries and number distribution. No number given out for a race within 30 minutes of its scheduled starting time.

Rules: ABL of A rules to govern. No allowance made for flat tires, mechanical failure or any type of accident. Distance lost must be regained by the contestant's own ability from point of mishap. Any rider lapped by the pack a second time will be ordered to withdraw from the race. At the end of 40 kilometers of the Senior race, officials reserve the right to order any rider off the course if he is not in contention for a place. Women race with men.

Equipment: Road bicycles only, with freewheels and two handbrakes in working order. Handlebars ends must be plugged. Crash helmets mandatory.

Parking: Contestants will be allowed to park on the diagonal access roads SE and SW corners of the Ellipse upon presentation of ABL of A racing license.
