PRIZES: \$1250 total value includes at least \$150 for prime sprint prizes in the Junior and Senior races. Prizes for first intermediate girl in the Women's race and the first girl in the Midget race. Prizes will be awarded immediately following the Senior race.

COURSE: Flat, 1 kilometer oval located just South of the White House. Registration Desk, start and finish lines at center of South side, just off Constitution Ave.

ENTRIES: Open to all licensed ABL riders. Intermediate girls ride with women and all midgets ride together. Post entries and unattached riders pay double. SIGNATURE OF PARENT or LEGAL GUARDIAN REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS UNDER 18. Early entry assures your name appearing in the race program.

REGISTRATION: 10:30 A.M. to 12:00 NOON for post entries and number distribution. Riders must present racing license and pay \$1.00 number deposit.

RULES: ABL of A rules to govern. No allowance made for flat tires, mechanical failures or any type of accident. Distance lost must be regained by the contestant's own ability from point of mishap. Any rider lapped by the pack a second time will be ordered to withdraw from the race. At the end of 40 kilometers of the Senior race, officials reserve the right to order any rider off the course if he is not in contention for a place.

EQUIPMENT: Road bicycles only, with freewheels and two handbrakes in working order. Handlebars' ends must be plugged. Crash helmets mandatory. SAFETY INSPECTION. **Midget Race:** Road bicycles with 24" wheels only.

PARKING: Contestants will be allowed to park on the diagonal access roads SE and SW corners of the Ellipse upon presentation of ABL of A racing license.
