RULES GOVERNING THE RACE

PRIZES: Trophies and \$2,000 in merchandise in accordance with ABL of A rules. In addition, there will be prime sprint prizes in the BAR races. The prizes for the preliminary races will be awarded after the Category 3 Senior/Veteran's race, and for the BAR events after the Senior race. Prizes awarded to the first girl in the midget and intermediate races and for the first Veteran in the Senior - 3/Veteran race.

COURSE: A flat, 1 kilometer oval located just south of the White House. Registration desk and Start/Finish line located at the center of the south side of the course, just off Constitution Avenue.

ENTRIES: Open to all ABL of A licensed riders. Senior riders must hold a Category 1 or 2 license to enter the Senior race. Category 3 seniors and Veterans ride in the Senior Category 3 race. Midget and Intermediate girls ride with boys. Post entries and unattached riders pay double. *Signature of Parent or legal Guardian required for all riders under 18.* Early entry assures your name appearing in the program. Race held rain or shine.

REGISTRATION: Open at 10:00 am. Post entries until 12:30 am. Number pick up until 15 minutes before each race. Riders must present racing license. No number deposit.

RULES: ABL of A rules to govern. No allowance made for flat tires, mechanical failures or any type of accident. Distance lost must be regained by the contestant's own ability from point of mishap. Riders lapped by the pack a second time will be ordered to withdraw. At the end of 40 kilometers in the Senior race, officials reserve the right to order any rider off the course if he is not in contention for a place.

EQUIPMENT: Road bicycles only, with freewheels and two handbrakes in working order. Handlebar ends must be plugged. Crash helmets mandatory. **SAFETY INSPECTION. MIDGET RACE:** Road bicycles with 24" wheels only.

PARKING: Contestants will be allowed to park on the diagonal access roads SE and SW corners of the Ellipse upon presentation of ABL of A racing license.
