LOCATION : "THE ELLIPSE", south of the White House, north of the Washington Monument and Constitution Ave., N.W., Washington, D.C.. Course is circular, level and .629 miles per lap.

ASSEMBLY: 12:30 PM at Constitution Ave. (south) side of Ellipse. No competitors numbers will be given out after 1:30 PM.

PRIZES: Over \$300.00 value in trophies and merchandise. Prizes will be presented by a representative of the Embassy of France.

EQUIPMENT: Optional, except that all bicycles must have at least one brake in good working order.

RULES: A.B.L. of A. rules to govern. No allowances for flat tires, mechanical failure or accidents of any type. Any lost distance must be made up by the contestant's own ability. No passing of refreshments to any rider during the races.

ENTRY FEES: Seniors - \$2.00 ; Juniors - \$1.00 . Post entry double. Entry fee must accompany entry blank. Minors must have signature of parent or guardian.
