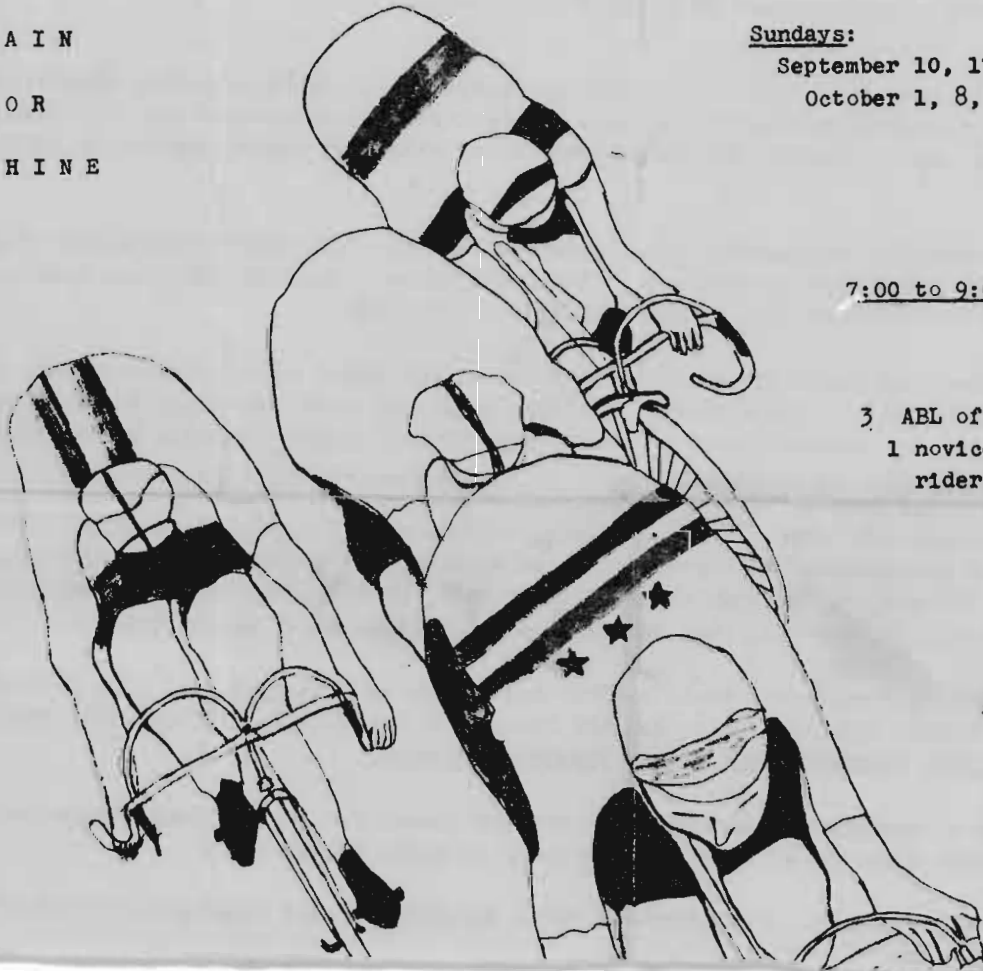

Separate classes for those holding ABL of A racing licenses and those who do not. Open to both sexes. Points awarded for each race, with overall winners determined by the highest number of points for the series. Trophies, medals and certificates given to winners in each class. RACES HELD RAIN OR SHINE.

Entries: Classes A thru C open to ABL of A registered riders only. Eastern Cycling Federation rules apply regarding ranking of classes. Class D for non-registered ABL of A riders 12 years and older. MINORS MUST HAVE SIGNATURE OF PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN ON ENTRY BLANK.

Registration: Advance registration requested. Mail to address shown. Post entries and number distribution at Rock Creek Park Headquarters, 1800 Beach Drive N. W. (near Military Road). ABL riders from 6:30 to 7:00 AM. Others from 7:30 to 8:15 AM.

Course: Runs clockwise down Beach Drive, right on Broad Branch Road, right on Glover Road, up the hill, right on Ross Drive down to Military Road exit ramp, and right to Beach Drive. Course is closed to automobiles. No riders will travel counterclockwise during races.

Rules: ABL of A rules to govern. All riders must wear crash helmets of racing or hockey type. No allowance made for flat tires, mechanical failure or any type of accident. Distance lost must be regained by the contestant's own ability from point of mishap. Feeding of riders not allowed. After completion of their race, participants will not congregate near the officials, nor will they ride across the finish line a second time.

Equipment: Road bicycles only with freewheels and two handbrakes in working order. ALL BICYCLES MUST HAVE PLUGGED HANDLEBAR ENDS, AND ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. BICYCLES NOT MEETING REQUIRED SAFETY STANDARDS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RACE.

Parking: Carter Barron Amphitheater parking lot (off 16th Street N.W. - walk down Morrow Drive) or Beach Drive north of Military Road or south of Broad Branch Road.
