In keeping with the purpose of the series, there are limitations on the size of gears that can be used and riders are urged to regard these races as training rather than as serious competition.

ENTRIES: Riders must hold or have applied for a 1973 ABL of A racing license. Women ride with men and the classes are as follows:

Class A - For the strongest and most experienced riders. Nominally for seniors but older juniors may enter.

Class B - Nominally for juniors, but experienced intermediates may enter.

Class C - Intermediates, Veterans and all new riders.

Midget - Boys and Girls 8 to 11 years old.

PRIZES: A total of \$250 worth of prizes will be awarded on the basis of overall standings for the series. The following point system will be used to calculate the overall standings:

Five places will receive prizes in classes A, B, and C. The number of places in the Midget class will depend on entries.

RULES: ABL of A rules govern. Road Bikes (2 working brakes and a free-wheel) only. Handlebars must be plugged. Helmets required. ECF regulations regarding ranking of classes apply. Bicycles will be inspected for maximum gear and safety.

DIRECTIONS: Take the George Washington Parkway south from Alexandria towards Mt. Vernon. Fort Hunt is on the right about 2 miles before Mt. Vernon. There is plenty of parking and registration will be set up near the main building on the left as you enter the park.
