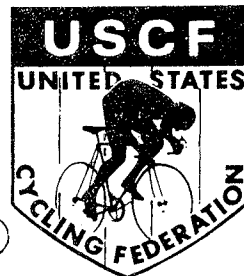

**REGISTRATION:** Rock Creek Park Headquarters, 1800 Beach Drive. Open at 7:30 a.m. Numbers distributed until 15 minutes before each race. Riders must have U.S.C.F. license in their possession.

**RULES:** U.S.C.F. rules apply. Road bikes only. Freewheel. Two working brakes. Plugged handlebar ends. Helmets, clean jerseys, black tights and white socks mandatory. Safety inspection. No allowance made for flats, accidents, or mechanical failures. Any lost distance must be made up by contestant's own ability. Race ends when leaders cross the line.

**COURSE:** Difficult 3.8 mile, 6 kilometer, hilly loop which runs clockwise down Beach Drive, right on Broad Branch Road, right on Glover Road, up the hill, right on Ross Drive, down to Military Road exit ramp, and right to Beach Drive. Course is closed to Automobiles. No riders will travel counterclockwise during the races.

**PARKING:** Carter Baron Amphitheater parking lot (off 16th St., N.W.--walk down Morrow Drive).

**DIRECTIONS:** I-95 to I-495, west to Exit 21, South on Georgia Ave., right on 16th Street to parking.
