DIRECTIONS

From North: Follow Washington Beltway (495) south and take exit marked "Frederick I-270 Only." Exit again, shortly, at Old Georgetown Road. Go east (towards D.C.) one light and turn right onto Rock Spring Drive (also marked with sign for Walter Johnson High School). Proceed straight for 1/4 mile to course.

From South: Follow Washington Beltway (495) north and take exit marked "Frederick I-270." Exit again, shortly, at Democracy Blvd East. Go approximately 1/2 mile to light on Old Georgetown Road. Take left on Old Georgetown and then left, shortly, onto Rock Spring Drive. Proceed straight for 1/4 mile to course.

From West: Take I-270 and follow signs to "Direction Virginia." Take exit at Democracy Blvd East and proceed as from South.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Clockwise, 2 km course with 2 right turns and good road surface. Uphill start, fast descent after first turn and slight uphill finish after second turn. Most riders will stay in the big ring.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

US Cycling Federation approved helmets are required for all riders (and helmets are mandatory while warming up -- violators may be banned from competition). All entry fees include insurance and MD/DE District Surcharge. Unattached USCF riders add \$5.00. Registration opens at 8:00 AM and all races will be held RAIN or SHINE. Field limit of 60 riders per class. Races should be conducted in order of listing above. However, the promoter reserves the right to combine classes and change race distances. The first race starts at 9:30 AM and all remaining races run sequentially thereafter. All racers must submit a "Standard USCF" entry form (these will be available to Citizen racers and post registrants on race day). Note: Parents or adult guardians must co-sign the release section of the standard entry for minor competitors.
