Monthly meeting: Monday, June 11, 7:30 P.M. in the conference room of Park Service Headquarters, 1100 Ohio Drive, Washington, D.C. The meeting agenda will include a film of the Tour of Nevada City, Calif., and a talk by Sgt. Stephan Livesay of the Park Police who will talk about cycling in Rock Creek Park from the police officer's point of view. A discussion period will follow during which other points of view may be exchanged. Also on the agenda is a proposal to form an NCVV team. While the club has had a very active program of promoting races in the Washington area, there has been no program for members competing in out of town races. It is now possible to consider the club's providing support to its members who compete actively in major races and to start to form an NCVV junior and senior team to compete in the Eastern Cycling Federation club team championships to be held in N.Y. on Sept. 16, 1973. Specific proposals will be presented at the June Meeting for discussion and immediate action.

National Capital Open: The National Capital Open will be held on the Ellipse on June 24th. Contrary to previous plans and the notice in last month's newsletter, unforeseen difficulties prevent us from using Rock Creek Park for a morning race. Therefore, the NCO will be an afternoon race at the Ellipse very much like last year. An entry is enclosed and all members are strongly urged to ride.
