Ellen Dorsey was named an alternate on the track squad.

The object of the ID program is to further strengthen and develop the U.S. women riders for international competition and to aid in the selection of international teams. A maximum of 10 road riders from each of the three regions (East, Midwest, and West), and 5 track riders from each region will participate in the program this year.

NCVC is fortunate in having four members named to the program, but it is only fair to expect that our club would stage an ID event sometime during the season. NCVC did have an ID event scheduled to be run in conjunction with the Senior III upgrade at Montclair, but as you may have heard, this event was cancelled.

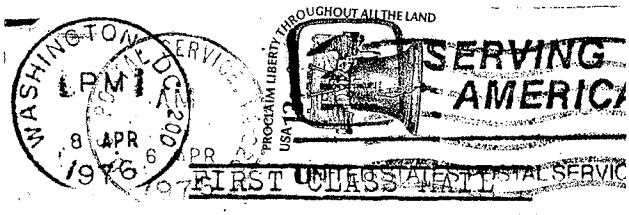
